



Announcement from the Digital Government Development Agency (Public Organization)

Subject: Policy on Not Accepting Gifts or Gratuities in the Performance of Official Duties
(No Gift Policy) for Fiscal Year 2026

In accordance with the National Reform Plan for Preventing and Suppressing Corruption and Misconduct (Revised Version), which identifies significant reform activities (Big Rock), all government agencies are required to declare themselves as organizations whose officials do not accept gifts or gratuities while performing their official duties (No Gift Policy).

The Digital Government Development Agency (Public Organization) hereby formally declares its commitment to upholding the highest standards of morality, ethics, and transparency, in alignment with the principles of good governance. Accordingly, all directors, officers, employees, and their family members shall refrain from accepting gifts, gratuities, property, or any other benefits, whether before, during, or after the performance of official duties. This policy aims to prevent favoritism, discrimination, or conflicts of interest that may lead to corruption or misconduct, either at present or in the future. All personnel are therefore required to strictly adhere to ethical standards concerning the receipt of property or other benefits, as prescribed in the Notification of the National Anti-Corruption Commission dated 19 February B.E. 2563 (2020) and the Regulations of the Prime Minister's Office on the Giving or Receiving of Gifts by Government Officials, B.E. 2565 (2022). In cases where there is a desire to convey goodwill on any occasion, employees are encouraged to use greeting cards or expressions via social media, rather than the exchange of gifts or gratuities.

This announcement is issued to ensure awareness and understanding among all personnel. All officials and staff members are expected to strictly comply with this policy without exception.
